Conditions governing permission to reproduce photographs of items in the Parliamentary Heritage Collections

1. All photographic images of items in the Parliamentary Heritage Collections have been made under the direction or control of:
 - (a) the House of Commons,
 - (b) the House of Lords, or
 - (c) both Houses jointly.
2. Accordingly, by reason of the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988, copyright in any such image belongs to the House of Commons, the House of Lords or (as the case may be) the two Houses jointly; and it is not to be reproduced without written permission from a member of staff of the UK Parliament Heritage Collections team acting on behalf of the Speaker of the House of Commons, the Clerk of the Parliaments or (as the case may be) the Speaker and the Clerk jointly
3. You acknowledge that the House of Commons, the House of Lords or (as the case may be) the two Houses jointly owns or own the Image and all title, interest and licensing rights in it.
4. The Image will be delivered in digital format. You will receive it via an emailed link to a site from which the Image can be downloaded or alternatively by post on a CD or DVD.
5. The licence to reproduce the Image accorded by the grant of permission ("the Licence")–
 - (a) is confined to the images listed and to the specific purpose indicated;
 - (b) confers no exclusive rights of reproduction or rights in perpetuity;
 - (c) is not to be sold, assigned, transferred or otherwise dealt with in the absence of permission in writing from a member of staff of the UK Parliaments Heritage Collection team;
 - (d) does not permit you to use the Image:
 - i. in relation to any scheme of free gifts, advertisement or inducement to purchase other articles,
 - ii. in such a way which, in the opinion of the UK Parliament Heritage Collection team, brings the UK Parliament into disrepute, or
 - iii. in a context which that team considers to be seriously misleading.
6. In the reproduction process, the Image may not be cropped, bled off the page, overprinted, printed on coloured stock, altered or manipulated in any way without prior written approval from the UK Parliament Heritage Collections team. If a detail is used it must be identified as such.
7. You must delete all digital images from computer databases on publication and not store them.
8. You must either return all discs containing images to the UK Parliament Heritage Collection team or destroy them upon publication of the Image. You must not store the discs.
9. The following credit line must be used whenever an image from the Parliamentary Heritage Collections is reproduced "© UK Parliament". In addition, the correct image caption details must be used and where required, the photographer must be credited. Failure to credit an image may result in additional fees being charged or the Licence being revoked.

10. If so required, proofs must be submitted for approval, and only such reproductions as are approved may be published. If no proofs are approved or where permission to reproduce is withdrawn, any reproduction fees already paid in connection with the specific project will be refunded.
11. Reproduction of the Image is only permitted from material supplied by UK Parliament Heritage Collection team.
12. A copy of the publication must be provided free of charge to that team upon publication.
13. All reproduction fees, photography costs, administration and postage charges must be paid to the House of Commons Administration before or permission to use the Image given.
14. This Licence may be revoked at any time if you are in breach of any of its terms.
15. You consent to allow the Corporate Officer of the House of Commons and/or the Corporate Officer of the House of Lords to process the personal data provided by you in connection with your application to reproduce the Image. Their privacy notices can be found here:
